As you drive down the road, call out the people you see and ask your child if Jesus loves them. Some examples would be, "Does Jesus love the man in the red car? Does Jesus love the woman in the blue dress? Does Jesus love the little girl who's crying? Does Jesus love the man who bagged our groceries?" Prompt your child each time to say, "Yes! Jesus loves everyone!" As you get out of the car, tell your child to look in the review mirror. Ask her, "Does Jesus love (name of child)?" Yes! Jesus loves everyone!
